### Integrated Care Service

#### What is the Home Accident Prevention Service?

A 'home accident prevention officer' (HAPO) will visit you at home to do a free safety check. During the visit they will check things such as carbon monoxide, flooring, and general safety, give you suitable advice, and provide solutions to allow you to stay safe and independent in your own home.

After your safety check, the HAPO will discuss and agree with you, any further work needed. If you require an interpreter, please let us know when you contact the service.

### How can I access the service?

To access the service you must have a G.P registered in Sandwell. The check is for any type of property.
