What is Sandwell Continence Support Group?

Sandwell Continence Support Group is a support group for men and women with continence problems. The group is open to anyone aged 18+ who is registered with a Sandwell GP.

If your answer to any of the following questions is yes, then the support group may benefit you:

- Are you having problems with your bladder or bowel?
- Do you need to go to the toilet frequently?
- Do you leak urine when you cough or sneeze?
- Have you had a prostate operation?

What happens at the support group?

The support group gives you the opportunity to meet and talk to other people who have similar continence problems.

An outside speaker comes to each of the meetings, to talk about things such as the effects of diet and exercise on your bladder and bowel, the support available to you and other health-related subjects and topics of interest.

One of our continence advisors is also available for you to have a private discussion withat each meeting.

When does the support group meet?

The group meets 4 times a year at Wood Lane Community Centre in West Bromwich, from 10.30am – 12.30pm.
