Who is the service for?

Our service is for patients with a bowel condition who have been referred to us by another health professional for advice and support.

What does the service provide?

We offer information, advice and support to you and your family while you are having treatment for your bowel condition. This includes before your hospital admission, whilst you are in hospital and following discharge home. You will also be able to contact us for support in the future if you need to.

Your key worker

You will be allocated a key worker, who is one of the nursing team. Your key worker can help you with any queries relating to:

- Tests and investigations
- Outpatient appointments
- Your treatment plan
- Access to the people looking after you at the hospital
