

## Commissioning for Quality and Innovation (CQUINs) 2019/20

The following draft CQUIN targets for 2019/20 are to be agreed with our NHS commissioners.

We assign CQUIN leads on clinical and operational levels to appropriately support each CQUIN. We publish monthly data on how we are doing against milestones and this is published in the Trust's Integrated Quality and Performance Report, which is discussed in our public board meetings. The NHS Commissioners are informed of progress on a quarterly basis.

1	CCG1a	AMR- Lower Urinary Tract Infections in Older People - Achieving 90% of antibiotic prescriptions for lower UTI in older people meeting NICE guidance for lower UTI (NG109) and PHE Diagnosis of UTI guidance in terms of diagnosis and treatment.
	CCG1b	AMR- Antibiotic Prophylaxis in colorectal surgery - Achieving 90% of antibiotic surgical prophylaxis prescriptions for elective colorectal surgery being a single dose and prescribed in accordance to local antibiotic guidelines.
2	CCG2	<b>Staff Flu Vaccinations</b> - Achieving an 80% uptake of flu vaccinations by frontline clinical staff.
3	CCG3a	<b>A&amp;T- Screening -</b> Achieving 80% of inpatients admitted to an inpatient ward for at least one night who are screened for both smoking and alcohol use.
	CCG3b	<b>A&amp;T</b> – <b>Tobacco Brief Advice</b> - Achieving 90% of identified smokers given brief advice
	CCG3c	<b>A&amp;T– Alcohol Brief Advice</b> - Achieving 90% of patients identified as drinking above low risk levels, given brief advice or offered a specialist referral.
7	CCG7	Three high impact actions to prevent Hospital Falls - Achieving 80% of older inpatients receiving key falls prevention actions.
9	CCG9	<b>Stroke 6 Month Reviews -</b> Achieving 55% of eligible stroke survivors receiving a six month follow up within 4-8 months of their stroke.
11	CCG11a	<b>SDEC – Pulmonary Embolus</b> - Achieving 75% of patients with confirmed pulmonary embolus being managed in a same day setting where clinically appropriate.
	CCG11b	<b>SDEC – Tachycardia with Atrial Fibrillation -</b> Achieving 75% of patients with confirmed atrial fibrillation being managed in a same day setting where clinically appropriate.
	CCG11c	SDEC – Community Acquired Pneumonia - Patients with or confirmed Community Acquired Pneumonia should be managed in a same day setting where clinically appropriate.
