The Board is discussing distinctly Unity Go Live, four hour wait times and winter beds.

The report focuses on operational delivery in Q1 and prospects for the balance of the year, as well as strategic alignment with STP partners and others. It bears highlighting that SWBH is now the best performing Trust in the Midlands for ambulance turnaround times and second-best for eliminating long lengths of acute hospital stay.

The current state of the delayed Midland Met FBC approval is explored and will be orally updated in the meeting. A deal must be struck by October 31st if we are to meet budget and timetable.
