ED 4 hour performance continues to underperform with January to date achieving 72.97%. Whilst recruitment is going well, the consistency in shift leadership practice and sustainability of improvement based change is the principal challenge. Improvement activities have proof of concept and need to be rapidly applied to gain improvement in time to admit or discharge.

There is good evidence of engagement and ownership from the speciality team, which must devolve at site level.

Focus through audit, risk management and attention to the experience of patients and our staff is integral to success and should be an equal focus of discussion.

- Patient safety and experience in the ED
- The intention for rapid improvement in February and confidence in delivery
- CQC readiness on the route to Good
