1. Suggested discussion points <i>[two or three issues you consider the Board should focus on]</i>					
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The recovery and restoration page shows that we are now off track to eliminate 52 week waits for inpatients by March 2021 and that we reached a new high of 648 52 week breaches in November. 1520 patients missed their clinical prioritisation date in total and in Ophthalmology patients missing their 4 day clinical prioritisation date jumped from one last month to 116 in November. The process of harm versus safety checks is not yet reporting. HSMR continues to rise. Coding work continues and is making progress based on lead measures (report to Quality and Safety Committee) but there is a time lag to it impacting the HSMR. The HSMR for weekend admissions is now 153 versus 133 in the week. Cancer recovers its 2 week wait performance but it still working to recover the 31 and 62 day standards. The post-partum haemorrhage performance recovers after a spike in October (8) and returns to 3 which is normal. Adult Sepsis reaches a high in terms of screened when required but is stubborn at ~80% in receiving treatment within the hour. The number screened positive as a % of being screened has increased steadily through the year from 16% to 26%. Falls rate which is now at a rate of 5.2 (per 1000 bed days) against the target rate of 5. 99 falls in November reported, but no cases with serious harm reported. Pressure ulcers increasing sharply to 76 in November (no grade 4). Both are comparable with peers; Neck of Femur recovering to target of 85% in November Flu vaccination at 76% and on target to deliver 80% at end of December
