Work to develop a complete set of outcome measures in this area continues.

A first draft for Sandwell went to the Place Based Partnership Board last month and further refinement was requested. This will take a few months to work through. However it should be noted that outcome measures will take a longer period of time to move and therefore aligned input and output measures that will show transitional performance and improvement are part of this development and will be used to track transformation progress.

As part of the system development work, NHSE are developing a broader set of Health Inequalities measures that are expected next year and will be used to align the system places together. In addition, work with public health to look at the wider determinants of health is underway.

In the meantime, place performance measures such as access and timeliness to services will be important milestones to assess the gaps in services and the wider place based pressure as the recovery post Covid continues. Never more so is this important given the drastic changes in access to primary care during the pandemic which in most cases has changed service flows for a generation.

The same piece of work is underway in Ladywood and Perry Barr although in this instance, the Trust is playing a supportive role rather than a leading one. Progress in this area hasn't been as quick but the momentum to commence this work is starting to build.
