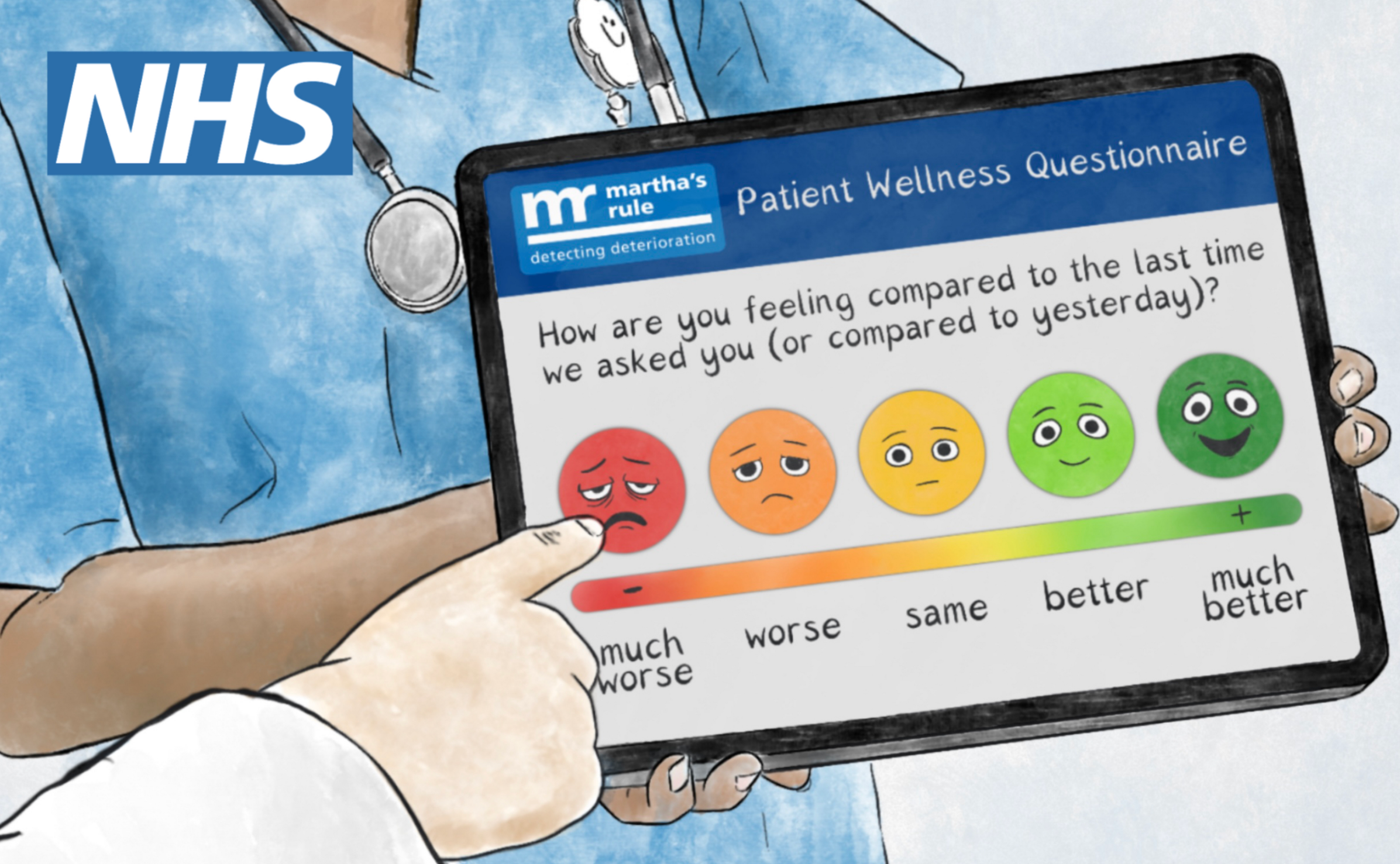




Martha's Rule: Detecting Deterioration

Martha's Rule gives you the right to ask for a rapid review if you're worried someone's condition is getting worse.

You know yourself and the people you care for better than anyone. Tell us when a change worries you.

- Patients will be asked daily how they are feeling, and if they are feeling better or worse. This information will be acted on in a structured way.
- If you notice changes which suggest a health condition is getting worse, please tell any of the staff looking after you or your loved one.
- If, after speaking to the care team, you remain worried and feel your concerns are not being addressed, call for a rapid review.

Call your hospital's dedicated number and ask for Call for Concern.
